

## MICRO EMBEDDED THREADING

### A new addition for Facial Rejuvenation in Aesthetic Medicine

Micro embedded threading or PDO thread lift is a lunchtime procedure to lift certain areas in the face that have sagged due to sun damage or the aging process. PDO (Polydioxanone) is a material that is commonly used in dissolvable sutures used by surgeons and dentists. These threads are inserted in targeted areas under the skin to stimulate the formation of collagen. Collagen is the tissue in skin that supports skin and stops the sagging process giving the skin a tightening effect. The most popular areas for the treatment are the cheeks, brow, nasolabial lines and the jaw line. This procedure can also be performed on other areas of the body such as the arms, buttocks and the breasts.

### Is the procedure painful?

It is a relatively painless procedure. A numbing cream is applied to the area where the threads are to be inserted.

### How does the procedure work?

The thread is inserted under the skin. Over a period of 6-7 months the threads dissolve. During this
